Brown Family Gives Capitol Support

CHATHAM, ONTARIO – Clare and Connie Brown were honoured at the Chatham Capitol Theatre for their major support, having sponsored 31 seats in the theatre’s seat naming sponsorship campaign. Mr. Robert Fox presented the couple with a Certificate in Recognition for the 31 names of Brown Family members, Great grandparents to eight grandchildren, who will have their names displayed on brass plaques placed on theatre seats.

The Browns’ ancestors moved to Canada in 1867. Clare now a retired teacher after 19 years at Tilbury District High School and 37 years in politics including positions as Councillor, Reeve and Mayor of Tilbury, commented. “Canada has invested in and has been good to the Brown Family. We felt the Brown Family should return a dividend to the community.”

Clare brown had an early interest in stage plays working on a stage crew at OAC College. He worked with the municipality and from his knowledge on council he said “Companies look at cultural factors when deciding to locate their business. The Capitol Theatre will make this area more appealing.”

The Brown’s seat sponsorship now at \$15,500 is the largest from an individual donor. Clare commented “I hate spending money but I love investing it.” Robert Fox, Project Manager for the Chatham Capitol Theatre in receiving the sponsorship said “The Browns have been long time supporters of the theatre. It’s an extraordinary show of community support.”
